### Morning Drop-Off Guidelines

✓ **Do:**

- Drop off children only along the sidewalk next to the playground.
- Keep children in the car until your vehicle is adjacent to the sidewalk.
- Stay in your vehicle during drop-off.
- Park in a designated spot if you need to walk your child to the entrance.
- Walk with your child if crossing the parking lot.

✗ **Don't:**

- Don't let children exit the car before reaching the sidewalk.
- Don't stop in the middle of the parking lot for drop-off.
- Don't allow children to walk through the parking lot without a parent.
- Don't leave your vehicle unattended in the drop-off zone.
