



### Uniform Guidelines – Easy Reference Table for Kindergarten - 8th grade

**Fall/Spring Seasons: August - October and April - June**

**Winter Season: November - March**

Category	Girls	Boys
<b>Tops</b>	Uniform polo-style shirt, long or short sleeve in solid gray, black, or burgundy. <b>No white.</b>	Uniform polo-style shirt in solid gray, black, or burgundy.
<b>Pants</b>	<b>Grades 5-8 only</b> solid black or gray cotton dress pants, no denim, joggers, or sweats. No cargo style pockets.	Same as girls.
<b>Shorts</b>	Solid gray or black cotton or twill, no more than 3" above the knee. <b>Khaki colored shorts are no longer allowed.</b>	Same as girls.
<b>Skirts/Skorts</b>	Gray/black (grades K-8) no more than 3" above the knee. <b>Fall/Spring seasons only.</b> Plaid (grades K-4) <b>Fall/Spring seasons only.</b> Plaid (grades 5-8) no more than 3" above the knee. <b>May be worn all year in place of pants.</b>	Not applicable.
<b>Jumpers</b>	<b>K-4 only</b> plaid jumpers no more than 3" above the knee. Jumpers may be worn all year. They are required for our winter season.	Not applicable.
<b>Belts</b>	Grades 4-8 Solid colored belts (black or brown are required).	Same as girls.
<b>Sweaters</b>	Solid black, gray, or burgundy, waist length, no hoods. Sweaters may be crewneck or V-neck pullover, or cardigan and must be worn over a uniform shirt. <b>Sweaters over t-shirts are not allowed.</b>	Same as girls

<b>Sweatshirts</b>	Approved St. Charles sweatshirt only, worn on Mondays. No hooded sweatshirts. Must be uniform colors.	Same as girls.
<b>Shoes</b>	Must be tied/fastened, closed-toe and back. Athletic or soft sole shoes. <b>No boots, light-ups, Crocs, high heels, flip flops, sandals, or heelies.</b>	Same as girls.
<b>Socks</b>	With plain skirt/skort/shorts: solid white, gray, black ankle/crew. With plaid: solid gray, burgundy, black, or white knee socks.	Solid white, gray, or black ankle/crew socks. Must be visible.
<b>Tights/Leggings</b>	Solid gray, burgundy, or black in stretchy cotton only. <b>No yoga pants, flared at the ankle, loose pants, or sweat pants under skirts or jumpers.</b>	Not applicable.
<b>Jewelry</b>	Discreet necklace or religious medal; 1 bracelet; post earrings only. No chokers, hoops, or dangles. <b>Students should be able to take care of their own earrings. Teachers will not be responsible for putting earrings in/out.</b>	Discreet necklace or medal; 1 bracelet. No earrings
<b>Hair</b>	Clean, neat, not covering eyes. No extreme styles or colors. Bows, headbands, ribbons, etc. must be small and in school colors.	Clean, neat, not covering eyes or collar. No extreme styles or colors.
<b>Makeup/Nails</b>	Minimal make up for grades 7&8. Clear nail polish only.	Not applicable.

## Charity Day/Jeans Day Guidelines – Easy Reference Table for Kindergarten - 8th grade

Category	Girls	Boys
<b>Tops</b>	T-shirts or sweatshirts allowed. No offensive words or designs. No tank tops or tight shirts.	T-shirts or sweatshirts allowed. No offensive words or designs. No tank tops.
<b>Bottoms</b>	Jeans - no rips or holes, athletic pants or shorts in appropriate condition and length. <b>Shorts may only be worn in Fall/Spring seasons</b> <b>No pajama pants.</b>	Same as girls.
<b>Leggings</b>	Permitted <b>only</b> when worn with a tunic length top or dress.	Not applicable.
<b>Shoes</b>	Must follow standard dress code (tied/fastened, closed-toe and back).	Must follow standard dress code (tied/fastened, closed-toe and back).
<b>Socks</b>	Required at all times.	Required at all times.
<b>General</b>	No spandex or tight-fitting clothing. Dress should remain modest and appropriate.	No spandex or tight-fitting clothing. Dress should remain modest and appropriate.
